McKINLEY MONUMENT AND McKINLEY  
MUSEUM OF HISTORY, SCIENCE, AND  
INDUSTRY (MMHSI)

LOCATION:

The Stark County Historical Society owns and administers the property known as McKinley Monument and park area (25 acres) and 1½ acres on which McKinley Museum of History, Science & Industry is located. The Society has been in operation since 1946 and since 1963 at its present location. In 1980 the facilities of the Museum were nearly doubled to accommodate the Science Hall and Street of Shops. Major areas of the Museum are as follows:

- (1) McKinley Hall/McKinley Monument
- (2) Science Hall/Human Growth
- (3) Street of Shops
- (4) Research Library
- (5) Historical Hall
- (6) Planetarium
- (7) Industrial Hall

The museum & monument are easily accessible just off I-77 at the 13th Street N.W. or 4th Street N.W. exits. The main entrance to the museum is at 7th Street N.W., through the edge of Monument Park.

THE MISSION OF THE SOCIETY:

- (1) The Mission of the Society is to promote historical research within the borders of Stark County & the collection, preservation & publications of historical material & dissemination of historical information about Stark County.
- (2) The Mission of the Society is to prepare exhibits associated with excellent education principles in history, science, and industry for the public interest.
- (3) The Mission of the Society is to provide physical facilities and educational programs for its public in promoting the 25th President of the United States - WILLIAM McKINLEY.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SOCIETY:

To attain the stated Mission(s), the Society seeks to successfully achieve the following objectives:

1. Provide library research facilities

and materials preserved and entrusted in the care by the political institutions of the county and the government of the United States.

2. Maintain the buildings & grounds of the McKinley Monument as a National heritage as prescribed in a deed to the Society from the State of Ohio.

3. Serve as an education institution in dissemination of research compiled by staff about Stark County & provide assistance for public interest in such research.

4. Serve as a teaching (Education) center for children and adults.

5. Disseminate knowledge about the three major component name descriptions of the operating name (McKinley Museum of History, Science & Industry (MMHSI))

a. Scientific

1. To provide "hands-on" science experiences for children & adults with respect to the natural laws of the universe;

2. To provide "hands-on" model demonstrations of health & human body functions, including human growth and development to school and auxiliary groups requesting such programs; and,

3. To provide lectures and educational opportunities for children and adults to learn about our solar system and univers through appropriate planetarium programs.

b. Historical

1. To assemble artifacts representative of historical Stark County;

2. To provide unique setting wherein guests observe various scenes of earlier Stark County; and,

3. Examine the relationship between various generations and programs in the development of the culture and resulting society of the region.

c. Industrial

1. To provide information regarding the conglomerate vastness of the industrial might of Stark County and its relationship to geopolitical consideration;

2. To provide opportunities for

citizens to learn specific information concerning products manufactured in the county; and,  
 3. To provide a forum wherein guests of the museum learn concomitantly organization & management of various industries.

#### COLLECTIONS OF THE MUSEUM:

##### (1) Street of Shops:

Consists of 11 authenticated shops, (18 to build) which depict Stark County (and most midwestern counties) as they were from 1820-1920. The artifact collection consists of three-dimensional objects (760) already in place, including furniture, glass, silver, ceramics, rings, fine art, tools and equipment of professionals and instruments and products made and/or invented by manufacturers of Stark County.

##### (2) Planetarium:

The Hoover-Price Planetarium consists of office and planetarium which seats 75 and served by a Spitz Model instrument. To provide programs, it houses over 200 projectors with associated software. On permanent loan are seven pieces of space equipment from the Smithsonian Institution.

##### (3) Research Library:

The research library was established to provide, among others, authentic information about the 25th President and Stark County. Over 2,000 pictures are contained in vertical files, while other vertical files are also available by subject and title. Five thousand volumes range in subject from histories of the county to pamphlets.

##### (4) Science Hall:

Major exhibits in the Science Hall vary from the Martin Glider, flown in 1908, (reconstructed by staff -- on loan from the Smithsonian Institution) to "hands-on" science experiences which teach a scientific principle. A human health and human science exhibit, illustrates various physical and natural functions.

##### (5) Industrial Hall:

At the present time nineteen exhibitors proved their story via "hands-on" exhibits through the use of audio visuals/or passive displays.

##### (6) Historical Hall:

The Historical Hall & balcony provide for scenes depicting Stark County in the 19th century. This permanent display area also houses special exhibits described elsewhere in this document.

##### (7) McKinley Monument and McKinley Hall:

The Monument, on 25 acres of land, is the repository of the remains of the President, his wife Ida, and their two infant children.

The park-like setting is used for concerts, architectural studies by local colleges and quiet recreational activities.

The McKinley Room, located in the Museum is the largest repository of McKinleyana anywhere in the world, with over 400 three-dimensional objects on display.
